
#### 1. TYBMS SEM-VI Analysis





- Nearly 44% of the students received ATKT.








## 2. TYBAF SEM-VI Analysis





- Nearly 44% of students received an ATKT, which suggests room for academic improvement.
- Despite males comprising over two-thirds of the batch, their pass rate is noticeably lower than that of females.








# **Comparative Summary**

- TYBMS and TYBCOM had nearly the same overall performance.
